

CDE Day— Things to Know!

Registration

- There will be only one registration time set up for all Career Development Events. All CDE teams should arrive at the Campus Agricultural Center (corner of Roger Road and Campbell Avenue, Tucson) by 7:00 a.m. to complete registration and obtain packets.
- Registration will be in front of the Meats Building (#2018) at the Campus Agricultural Center (Farm) beginning at 7:00 a.m. Please see the agenda for times and locations of each Career Development Event.
- Buses for the Dairy Management CDE will depart from the Campus Agricultural Center as soon as registration is complete.

On Campus Parking

- **The Lots 8111 and 8112** will be reserved for the buses, small buses, and vans. The following is suggested (please see maps):
Lot 8112 – please park small buses and vans
Lot 8111 – please use this lot for the full sized buses
- Parking and Transportation expects you to come to campus to drop off at two separate times.
 - ◇ **The first time is: 8:00 a.m. (approximately) – On campus events**
 - ◇ **The second time is: 2:00 p.m. (approximately) – Awards**
- **PLEASE UNLOAD THE STUDENTS ON THE WEST SIDE CURB ON NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP DRIVE BETWEEN THE FOOTBALL AND BASEBALL STADIUMS.** Please ask the driver to unload and relocate in a timely manner to allow all buses onto campus without causing traffic congestion.
- Please do NOT unload students near Old Main. The U of A has too much traffic now to accommodate buses and vans unloading in that area.
- State vehicles may park in service permit spots on campus. However, please pay attention to the time limit. Most have two-hour limits.

Campus Ag Center Parking

Directions from Freeway

- **The construction is finished**, so you should be able to exit I-10 at Prince Road.
- Travel south on I-10 for nearly 2 hours from Phoenix. Exit east [left] on Prince Road.
- After several miles turn north [left] on Campbell Ave.
- After about 1 mile turn left [west] on Roger Road.
- Turn right at the first driveway.
- Access to the Campus Agricultural Center for all cars and buses is from Campbell Ave **onto** Roger Road (south of the Center). **Please instruct your bus drivers that both entrance and exit will be off Roger Road.**
- Buses will park as they enter on the left; vans will park on the right; and the cars should park on the north side of Meat Lab.
- Campus Ag Center personnel will direct parking, so please follow their directions.

Lunch

- The U of A campus offers a variety of eating establishments; however, the Campus Ag Center does not. Your students, especially those who are competing in Dairy, should bring bag lunches if they are spending most of their day at the Campus Ag Center.
- As an alternative to bag lunches, The Jacobs-Cline Society is serving lunch at the Campus Ag Center, directly north of the ABE laboratory (affectionately known as Charlie's shop). The menu will include: Hamburger, Chips, and Soda for \$5.00.
